[Notes to the table]

- For example, the value “25” in the dose row “1<Dose ≤2” in the period column “April–June 2021” indicates that there were 25 workers engaged in decontamination and related work in the three months from April to June 2021 who had a dose higher than 1 mSv and equal to or lower than 2 mSv.
- This table shows the dose distribution per quarter, collected as of 11 July 2022 for the past one year.
- The data are given as a flash report of the dose distribution among workers engaged in decontamination and related work in the first quarter (January–March of 2022) as well as additional data for the period from the second quarter of 2021 to the fourth quarter of 2021 (April 2021 to December 2021) which were added after the flash data collection day (18 April 2022)
