[Notes to the table]

- For example, the value "161" in the dose row "1<Dose ≤2" in the period column "April–June 2019" indicates that there were 161 workers engaged in decontamination and related work in the three months from April to June 2019 who had a dose higher than 1 mSv and equal to or lower than 2 mSv.
- This table shows the dose distribution per quarter, collected as of 12 July 2020 for the past one year.
- The data are given as a flash report of the dose distribution among workers engaged in decontamination and related work in the first quarter (January–March of 2020) as well as additional data for the period from the second quarter of 2019 to the fourth quarter of 2019 (April 2019 to December 2019) which were added after the flash data collection day (28 May 2020)
