[Notes to the table]

- For example, the value "297" in the dose row " 1<Dose ≤2" in the period column "January–March 2017" indicates that there were 297 workers engaged in decontamination and related work in the three months from January to March 2017 who had a dose higher than 1 mSv and equal to or lower than 2 mSv.
- This table shows the dose distribution per quarter , collected as of 24 April 2018 for the past one year.
- The data are given as a flash report of the dose distribution among workers engaged in decontamination and related work in the fourth quarter (October–December of 2017) as well as additional data for the period from the first quarter of 2017 to the third quarter of 2017 (January 2017 to September 2017) which were added after the flash data collection day (9 January 2018)
