[Notes to the table]

- For example, the value "199" in the dose row "1<Dose ≤2" in the period column "January–March 2019" indicates that there were 199 workers engaged in decontamination and related work in the three months from January to March 2019 who had a dose higher than 1 mSv and equal to or lower than 2 mSv.
- This table shows the dose distribution per quarter, collected as of 28 May 2020 for the past one year.
- The data are given as a flash report of the dose distribution among workers engaged in decontamination and related work in the fourth quarter (October–December of 2019) as well as additional data for the period from the first quarter of 2019 to the third quarter of 2019 (January 2019 to September 2019) which were added after the flash data collection day (15 January 2020)
