[Notes to the table]

- For example, the value "103" in the dose row " 1<Dose ≤2" in the period column "July–September 2019" indicates that there were 103 workers engaged in decontamination and related work in the three months from July to September 2019 who had a dose higher than 1 mSv and equal to or lower than 2 mSv.
- This table shows the dose distribution per quarter, collected as of 18 October 2020 for the past one year.
- The data are given as a flash report of the dose distribution among workers engaged in decontamination and related work in the second quarter (April–June of 2020) as well as additional data for the period from the third quarter of 2019 to the first quarter of 2020 (July 2019 to March 2020) which were added after the flash data collection day (12 July 2020)
