[Notes to the table]

- For example, the value "251" in the dose row " 1<Dose ≤2" in the period column "January–March 2018" indicates that there were 251 workers engaged in decontamination and related work in the three months from January to March 2018 who had a dose higher than 1 mSv and equal to or lower than 2 mSv.
- This table shows the dose distribution per quarter, collected as of 14 April 2019 for the past one year.
- The data are given as a flash report of the dose distribution among workers engaged in decontamination and related work in the fourth quarter (October–December of 2018) as well as additional data for the period from the first quarter of 2018 to the third quarter of 2018 (January 2018 to September 2018) which were added after the flash data collection day (23 January 2019)
