[Notes to the table]

- For example, the value “ 6 ” in the dose row “ 1<Dose ≤2 ” in the period column “ July – September 2024 ” indicates that there were 6 workers engaged in decontamination and related work in the three months from July to September 2024 who had a dose higher than 1 mSv and equal to or lower than 2 mSv.
- This table shows the dose distribution per quarter, collected as of 14 October 2025 for the past one year.
- The data are given as a flash report of the dose distribution among workers engaged in decontamination and related work in the second quarter (April – June of 2025) as well as additional data for the period from the third quarter of 2024 to the first quarter of 2025 (July 2024 to March 2025) which were added after the flash data collection day (14 July 2025).
