[Notes to the table]

- For example, the value “ 14 ” in the dose row “ 1<Dose ≤2 ” in the period column “October – December 2023” indicates that there were 14 workers engaged in decontamination and related work in the three months from October to December 2023 who had a dose higher than 1 mSv and equal to or lower than 2 mSv.
- This table shows the dose distribution per quarter, collected as of 14 January 2025 for the past one year.
- The data are given as a flash report of the dose distribution among workers engaged in decontamination and related work in the third quarter (July – September of 2024) as well as additional data for the period from the fourth quarter of 2023 to the second quarter of 2024 (October 2023 to June 2024) which were added after the flash data collection day (9 October 2024).
